# Why PRIDE?

- To help students establish the necessary and beneficial study skills that will ensure your child's success in school now and in the future.
- Students are responsible for their own actions, and for coming to school ready to learn.



# What is PRIDE?

- Personal Responsibility In Daily Effort
- Students will arrive to school and class on time
- Students will complete and turn in assignments on the day they are due
- Students will come to class prepared (materials, books, paper, pencil, etc)



# How does PRIDE work?

- Each child will be given a stamp sheet every quarter.
- As long as the expectations are followed they will get a stamp.
- Academically driven
- Free stamps



# Rewards

- Weekly- Students who have perfect pride for the week can have their names put in for a weekly drawing.
- Monthly- Students who have perfect PRIDE for the month will receive a “Homework Pass.” The student must check with the teacher to first determine if the homework pass can be used for that assignment.
- Quarterly- Students will be given award certificates and be able to participate in the school reward activity.



# What happens if I get PRIDE?

- Call parents in the class you receive PRIDE
- Last hour teacher collects stamp sheets and walks students to PRIDE room
- PRIDE is from 3:50-4:35. There is no leaving early.



# What will my child be doing in PRIDE?

- If they received an H in any class that day they are required to complete that assignment
- Homework from that day
- Teacher will be in there to help students
- Enrichment packets



# Consequences

- 1<sup>st</sup> no show- reassigned the next day
- 2<sup>nd</sup> no show-ISS
- 3<sup>rd</sup> no show/excessive PRIDES- parent meeting and student put on behavior contract
- If student violates the behavior contract it could be alternative placement



# Miscellaneous

- If students have an appt on the day they receive PRIDE parents must call the front office prior to 3:50 to get it rescheduled or it will count as a no show.
- If students lose their stamp sheet a replacement is given and they serve PRIDE and are ineligible for any rewards for that quarter.
- 2 or more T, H, M will result in Pride and lunch detention
- Forgetting to get a stamp will result in PRIDE.
- Forging or altering a stamp might result in an outside of school suspension.
