#### CPR TRAINING FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Students will be trained in CPR using the American Red Cross CPR Training curriculum and will be trained by certified Red Cross presenters. Your child will receive this training on one of the dates listed below unless you indicate otherwise. Please note: this training does not qualify students to obtain a certified CPR/First Aide Card.
