

Participation Points Make-Up Assignments

When you are absent, you lose participation points. If your absence is excused, please choose one of the following assignments to make up your points. The paper heading should include your name, class period, date, and the date of your absence, as well as the assignment type you've chosen below:

1. **ANNOTATE and SUMMARY** an article related to theatre. Write a one page summary of an article read about theatre. The article may be from any magazine, e-zine, professional blog, or newspaper, but not a personal blog. Check out: www.schooltheatre.org or www.theatrefolk.com. Write in paragraph form and use complete sentences, correct spelling, proper grammar, punctuation and citations. Use the outline provided to receive full points. This assignment will make up one excused absence.
 - i. 1st Paragraph: Review
 1. Give an overview of the information you read. Write in your own words. Use quotation marks and cite properly when quoting from the article.
 - ii. 2nd Paragraph: Personal Reaction
 1. Discuss why you chose this topic.
 2. Explain what you gained by studying this topic.
 - iii. Attach the annotated copy of the article.
2. **ATTEND A THEATRE PERFORMANCE** and write a 1-2 page summary and/or reaction to the performance. Attach your ticket stub or program to the paper. This assignment will make up two absences.
3. **RESEARCH** a famous actor, technician, or a career in technical theatre. Write a 2 page paper on your findings. Make sure to properly cite your information. This assignment will make up one absence.

Turn in the make up assignments into the appropriate class tray and make sure your name is on them! Remember that DUE DATES are the Monday before the end of the quarter. Late makeup work will not be accepted.
