

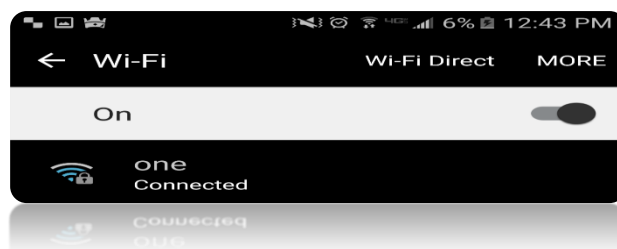
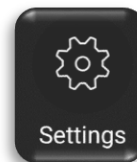

Connecting Your Android Devices to Wi-Fi

Connecting your Android device to the HUSD wireless network is as easy as 1 – 2 – 3.

1. Connect to the HUSD network.

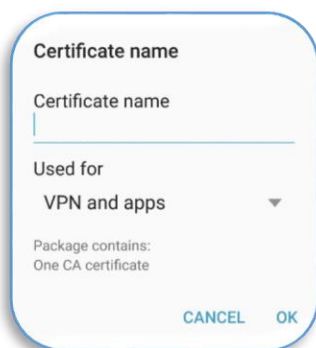
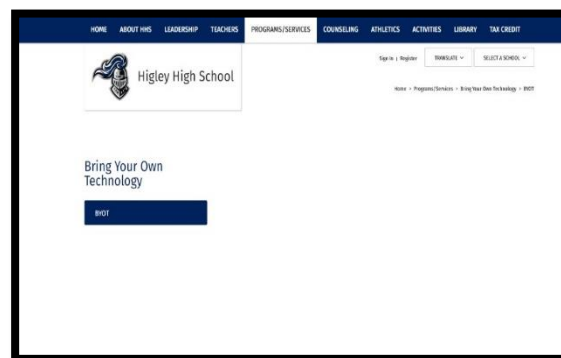
- Open Settings.
- Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled and turned to “on.”
- Choose the “one” network.



2. Download and install the certificate

Open a browser and go to www.husd.org/byot

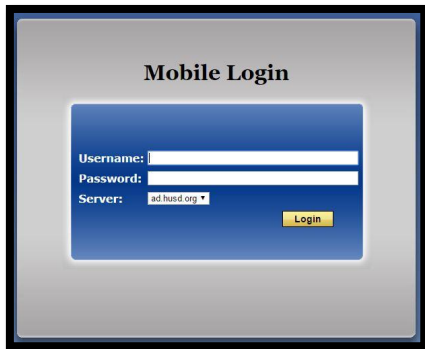
Scroll down to find [Download required certificate](#) link and click to begin the download.



Once download completes, a prompt will follow to choose and enter “Web Filter” for the HUSD certificate and press “OK.”

3. Log into the HUSD Web Filter

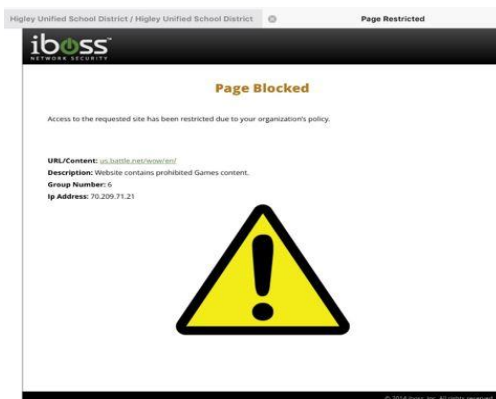
- Find the [Log in to the Guest Network](#) link under the “pages” at the top left corner of the device. Here you will be prompted with instructions.
- Log in with your student credentials.
- Don’t forget to keep this tab open to ensure continuous access. If idle, the session will timeout in 15 minutes.
- Congratulations! You are now connected to the HUSD network!



Troubleshooting Connectivity Problems
