Connecting Your Apple Devices to Wi-Fi

Connecting your Apple device to the HUSD wireless network is as easy as 1 – 2 – 3.

1. Connect to the HUSD network

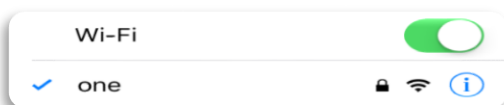
- Open Settings



- Ensure Wi-Fi is turned on

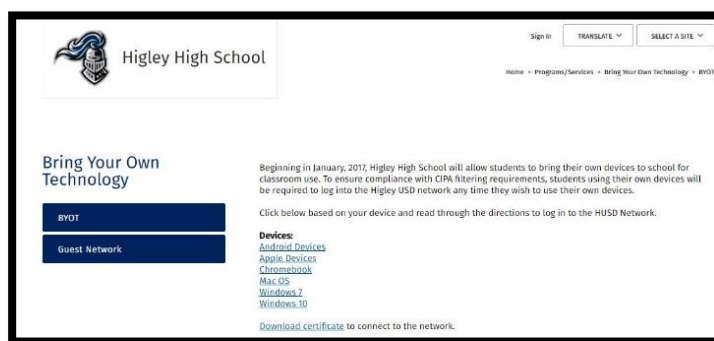


- Choose the “one” network



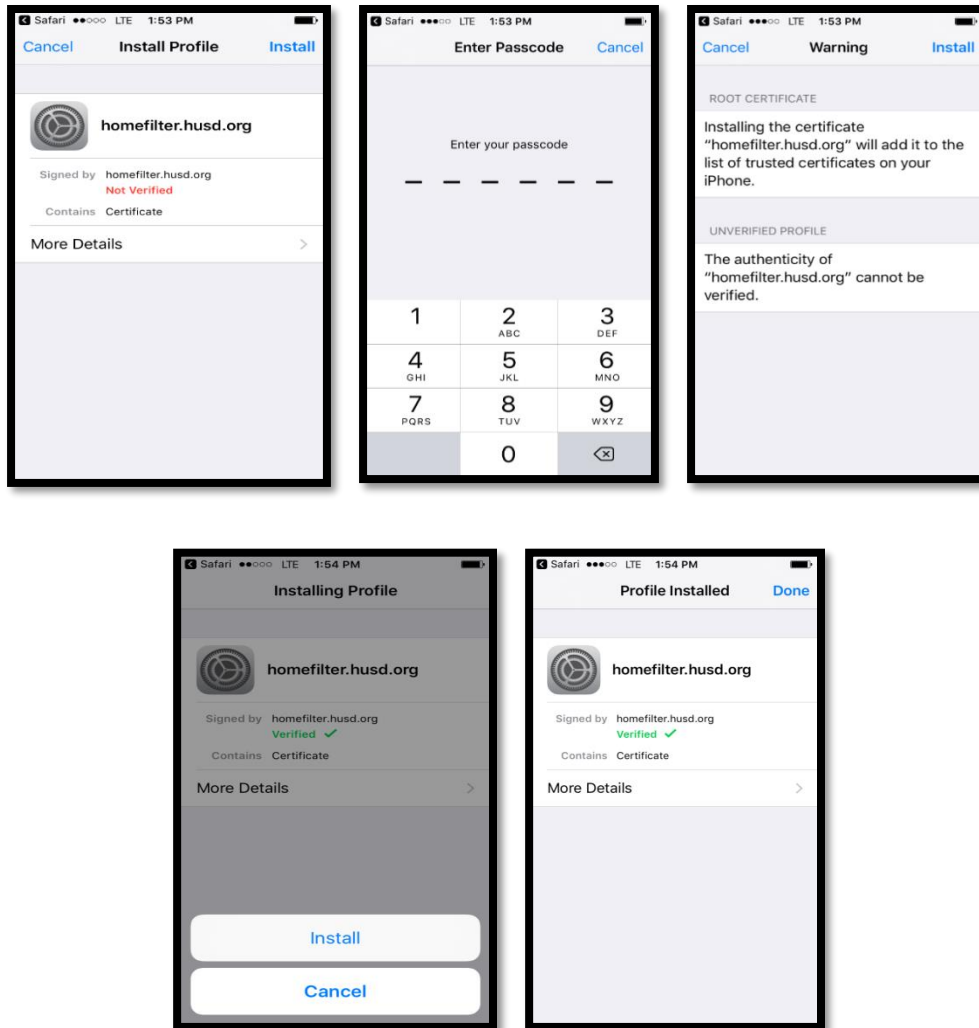
2. Download and install the certificate

Go to www.husd.org/byot and locate the [Download the required certificate](#) link. Here you will be prompted with instructions. You will be asked to download the network security certificate.



On your device:

- Click “install” in the upper right corner.
- Enter your lock code (if applicable) and press “install” again.
- Press “install” one last time for confirmation
- Click “Done” to finish this part of the process.

3. Log into the HUSD Web Filter

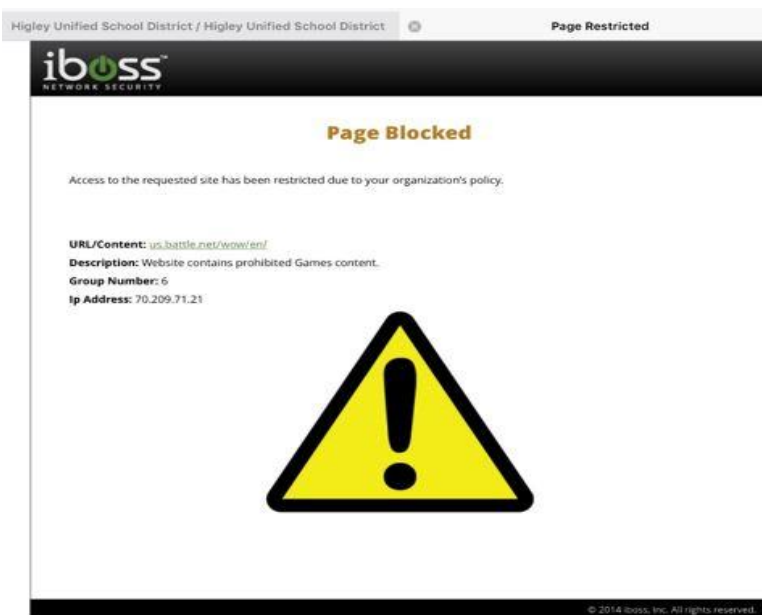
- Find the link [Log in to the Guest Network](http://www.husd.org/byot) on the HUSD.org (<http://www.husd.org/byot>). Under the pages link at the top left corner.
- Here you will be prompted with instructions
- Log in with your student credentials
- Don't forget to keep this tab open to ensure continuous access. If idle, the session will timeout in 15 minutes.
