
Once logged in, if idle the session will timeout in 15 minutes. This tab must remain open in order to keep an active session.


Select 'save' to download the file:




 Select 'automatically select the certificate store based on the type of certificate', click 'Next':






## **Troubleshooting Connectivity Problems**



Example 1: Unable to connect to the Internet. "There is no Internet Connection". Please open up a new tab in your browser and go to <a href="filter.husd.org/mobileLogin">filter.husd.org/mobileLogin</a> and sign in using your HUSD username & password.



#### Example 2:

You are unable to log in the web proxy server or load the login page. Please check your Wi-Fi connection. At first glance you should see the Wi-Fi status antenna in the lower right hand corner. Next check your wireless settings & ensure your Wi-Fi button is turned **on**. You can also try restarting your device.



Example 3: You have been blocked by the HUSD web filter. Please verify the url (web page) you are trying to reach was accurately typed. Content is restricted in compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act.
