



Talking Points

- Students who opt to return to face-to-face instruction will return to remote style instruction if the school is closed during the year.
- Students who opt for the online instructional option will remain in the online format even if schools close during the year.
- Students may have different teachers if they move to the online program
- Students may have different teachers when moving from Remote to in-person if their teacher moves to Online modality
- Online program staffed with current Higley certified staff
- Students may return to face-to-face instruction from the online model without incurring a significant gap in instruction
- Teachers will use components of the FLVS curriculum in the online environment as supplemental resources.
- Required face-to-face times in all online environments this school year
- Students remain “enrolled” in their home school for entire school year, regardless of modality
- Students who wish to remain in online learning environment for 21-22 school year will enroll in the **Higley Virtual Academy** online program.
